Assistance with fees and discounts

We offer a **15% discount** for the second, or subsequent, child attending nursery at the same time on a permanent booking. Please note, this discount cannot be used in conjunction with a fully funded package.

All children over the age of three are eligible for the universal '**Early Years Free Entitlement**'. This entitles them to **15 hours** of funded nursery education for 38 weeks of the year from the term after their 3rd birthday. For those who are eligible for **30 hours** of childcare we are pleased to say that we offer up to 30 hours of funding. For more information on how this works in our setting, please see our 15 Hours and 30 Hours Free Entitlement information sheets.

You may be able to reduce your nursery fees by 20% (up to £2000) using the government's **Tax-Free Childcare** scheme. This is a scheme that eligible parents must register for themselves and cannot be used in conjunction with Childcare Vouchers.

We accept eligible **Childcare Vouchers**.

Notes

Opening times are between 8.00am and 6.00pm Monday-Friday. The nurseries close between Christmas and New Year's Day and are closed for bank holidays.

We do not charge for the 8 statutory bank holidays or for the days closed over the Christmas period. This may save you up to £600-£800 per annum (depending on your booking pattern) when compared with other nurseries.

Monthly invoices are calculated according to booked pattern, based on the number of days booked in each month.

Extra days are charged at £84/day. Please note, cancellations of booked extra days are charged at £7.50.
